

## CAMPAIGN PLEDGE

With our nation at war and our economy in uncertain times, I believe it is important to unite our country and maintain faith in the integrity of our government leaders. As campaign tactics have the potential to harm public faith and undermine confidence in America's democratic system, I hereby pledge that, as a candidate for the United States House of Representatives, I will:

ABIDE BY the teaching of my faith and follow the Ten Commandments as laid out in Exodus Chapter 20 of the Old Testament, specifically the 9<sup>th</sup> Commandment, and the teachings of Christ on the "greatest commandment" as put forth in Matthew 22: 36-40;

CONDEMN the use of whisper campaigns, libel, slander, or attacks on my opponent's family members;

CONDEMN the use of campaign material of any sort that misrepresents, distorts, or otherwise falsify the facts regarding my opponent, his political party, or another elected official as well as the use of malicious or unfounded accusations against any candidate or party;


CONDEMN any appeal to prejudice based on race or creed;

DISAVOW PUBLICLY any material and advertising that are not factually accurate or that fail to disclose the identity behind such campaign activities and the source of funding;
